**Need Waterloo and Upper Chesapeake**

- Complete History & Physical:** Must be performed with-in 30 days of surgery, Valid for 30 days only.
- Covid Testing:** required for All patients within 96hrs of Surgery, Your Surgical Coordinator will assist with Scheduling.
- EKG:** Age 60 years or older, History of Cardiovascular Disease ischemic heart disease, Diabetes Mellitus, Radiation or Chemotherapy, Renal Disease, uncontrolled hypertension, Cerebrovascular disease (i.e. previous CVA OR TIA), Morbid Obesity (BMI > 40) Obstructive Sleep Apnea, Hx of Premature cardiac disease, Major Cardiac/Vascular Surgery, Major Abdominal, Orthopedic, Thoracic Surgery. **Valid for 6 months if no changes in clinical status.**
- CHEST XRAY:** complete for Disease (Acute, Moderate or Severe COPD or Acute CHF, current or recent CHF, Morbid Obesity, suspected acute pulmonary disease, abnormal chest exam)
- Specialty clearance (cardiac, oncology, pulmonary, oncology):** complete 2-3 weeks before surgical procedure
  - schedule appointments with your specialists to receive clearance for surgery. Within 12 months for stable risk factors. Within 30 days of surgery for Cardiac event with in the last year (chest pain, new atrial fibrillation or other arrhythmia, Heart Failure, Cardiac Surgery, or Angioplasty). Echo with in 24 months for a patient with asymptomatic aortic stenosis, pulmonary hypertension, heart failure.
- Lab Testing:** Must be completed within 30 days of surgery, Preferable 2- 3 weeks prior to surgery, Valid for 30 days Only.
  - HIV positive patients need a CD4 count and viral load values.
  - Diabetic patients need a hemoglobin A1C (HgbA1c), Fasting Glucose Level

### Standard Labs:

- CBC w Diff, Hemoglobin/Hematocrit, PT/PTT& PT/INR, BMP, CMP, LFT'S, U/A
